# NORTHERN VIRGINIA SWIMMING LEAGUE 2010 Scholarship Application

Scholarships are awarded each year by the Northern Virginia Swimming League to assist NVSL graduates defray a portion of their continuing education expenses. This year the NVSL will award scholarships to graduating high school swimmers and/or divers\* to be used at the school of their choice. Swimmers who have accepted swim/dive scholarships to a Division I or Division II school as a general rule are ineligible for this scholarship according to NCAA guidelines.\*\*

## Criteria for the selection process include:

- 1. Swim/Dive Team Commitment and Leadership
- 2. School and Community Involvement
- Response to NVSL Scholarship Essay Topic Question
   Please collate each packet and staple. Do not put applications in notebooks or folders.

## **Application Process**

- 1. Applicants must fill out the attached Personal Data Sheet. It should be typed and not exceed 2 pages.
- 2. Attach no more than *three letters* of recommendation prepared by someone who knows the swimmer/diver (for example, a team representative, coach, school counselor, etc.). The letters should be formatted as follows:
  - a. typewritten
  - b. one inch margins
  - c. size 12 or larger font (Times New Roman preferred)
  - d. 8 1/2 x 11" paper
  - e. each letter may not exceed 1 page
  - f. indicate how the applicant has made a difference to his/her NVSL team while upholding the NVSL philosophy

NOTE: Attach the recommendation letters to the scholarship packet (do not submit separately). Make 5 copies of each letter and submit with the application.

- 3. Applicant must attach an essay response to the NVSL Scholarship Essay topic question. The response should be:
  - a. no more than 1 typewritten page
  - b. written in Times New Roman size 12 font with 1" margins
  - c. double spaced
  - d. be on 8 1/2" x 11" paper
  - e. include the title...NVSL Essay
- 4. Each applicant must furnish 6 copies of the completed application packet to the Scholarship Committee (one original application packet and five copies of the original application packet. Include copies of the letters of reference.) E-mail applications will NOT be accepted.
- 5. Applications are due not later than 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 24th

- \* If this is the final year of NVSL eligibility for the swimmer/diver, but for some reason he/she has not graduated from high school, the individual is eligible to compete for the NVSL scholarship.
- \*\* The applicant should contact his/her college or university team to determine eligibility to accept the NVSL scholarship prior to applying for the scholarship.
